Survivor Story

Success through DVRC's Housing Program

In 2017, a survivor sought emergency confidential shelter for domestic violence at Monika's House, the shelter run by DVRC. After the survivor's time at Monika's House, they transitioned to Mary Mac House and entered DVRC's transitional housing program. The survivor worked through emotional ups and downs, counseling, medical issues, the death of a family member, family trauma, personal transitioning, communal living, and agency trauma, among other barriers, to achieve **complete self-sufficiency and independence**.



Toward the end of their time at Mary Mac, they secured long term housing, an immediate job, and job training for their ideal career. Thanks to financial assistance through DVRC, this survivor was able to rent a truck to drive to a state across the country and begin the

next chapter of their life. They began working in the social service field while attending further job training. This survivor has thanked DVRC Housing Staff tremendously for continual support and is excited to see the upward direction that the housing program is moving in.
